Adjectives of the First and Second Declension

The majority of Adjectives belong to this group.

The Masculine forms are declined like **λογος**

The Feminine forms are declined like **ἀρχη** for stems ending in a consonant,
or like **ἡμερα** for stems ending in a vowel or rho.

The Neuter forms are declined like **ἔργον**
